**Washoe County Sheriff's Office Announces Fourth of July Traffic and Parking Controls for Holiday**

**INCLINE VILLAGE, NV** – The Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the Incline Village General Improvement District (IVGID) remind residents and visitors to the Incline Village area that this will be a very busy Fourth of July weekend in Incline Village. Please review the following road closures and no parking areas as it may affect your commute. Plan your visit in advance and please use patience and caution while traveling during the holiday weekend.

*The following traffic and parking controls are planned for Saturday, June 30<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018:*

**Road Closures on Wednesday, July 4:**

- Lakeshore Blvd will be CLOSED on July 4th (between Village and Country Club) from 8:00 p.m. until after the fireworks display.

**One Way Traffic on Wednesday, July 4, 5:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.:**

- ONE LANE TRAFFIC will be open to through traffic on Lakeshore Blvd. from Village Blvd. to Country Club Drive (West to East). One lane will be used for loading and unloading only.
- Incline Way from Country Club Drive to Southwood Blvd. (East to West).

**No Parking Areas:**

- There will be NO PARKING on Village Blvd (Southwood Blvd to Lakeshore Blvd) and Lakeshore Blvd (Village to Country Club) beginning Saturday, June 30<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 5th. There will be limited handicap parking available on Lakeshore Blvd in front of Incline Beach gate. There will be restricted parking on Incline Way due to one way traffic.

\*\*\* Vehicles parked in NO PARKING ZONES will be towed at the owner's expense and may contact Alpine Towing at (775) 833-9777 for recovery.
